



The **Lectopia** system enables automated digital recording of lectures based on a schedule supplied by lecturers.

Recordings are accessed as streaming media over the web or as MP3 download (when requested). The University has 44 venues on campus set up for automatic recordings.



The **MyMedia** service is an online tool that allows teaching and support staff to upload and manage their own video and audio files.

The MyMedia service also features podcasting channel creation and hosting, along with hosting of podcasting content.

Supported eLearning Services



Respondus is a Microsoft Windows application that enhances the functionality and usability of WebCT's Evaluation tools (quiz, survey, and self-test). It can also be used to create paper based versions of online quizzes.



My eLearning Vista is used to provide online learning and teaching environments that supplement both face-to-face teaching and distance learning course materials. It is also used to deliver a small number of fully online courses.



Wimba is a voice discussion and chat system that is integrated within my eLearning Vista. It provides asynchronous discussion forums where participants can leave voice/text messages for later review by other course participants. It also provides synchronous chat room facilities that allow participants to meet virtually at designated times and discuss things in a similar fashion to telephone or other forms of online conferencing.



Turnitin is a hosted service that maintains a database of submitted papers and internet pages both past and present and subscriptions to journals and periodicals. Against this historical database and the current state of the internet it automatically generates reports as to whether it finds similarity between submitted papers and those that it can find and has stored. Turnitin is best known for its 'plagiarism' detection tool,
